**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' EMERGENCY MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO TEMPORARY FILE ENTIRE CASE UNDER SEAL**

Before the Court is Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Leave to Temporary File Entire Case Under Seal. Upon consideration of the Motion, the pleadings filed herein, and the arguments of counsel, the Court finds the applicable rules and Second Circuit precedent are satisfied, that the requested order to seal the docket is the least restrictive means available to protect the interests of Plaintiffs, their customers and member organizations, and the public, and that there is a compelling need to enter a temporary sealing order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this case shall be filed and maintained UNDER SEAL in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(c)(1), pending execution of the *ex parte* relief requested in Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Application for an Emergency Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction, which Plaintiffs intend to file on August 26, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, immediately upon execution of the *ex parte* relief disabling the domains to be identified in **Appendix A** to the forthcoming Complaint, sought in Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Application for an Emergency Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction, Plaintiffs shall file with the Clerk of the Court a Notice that the Temporary Restraining Order has been executed. Upon filing of such Notice, the case and the docket shall be immediately deemed unsealed pursuant to this Order, and upon filing of the Notice all of the foregoing documents may be disclosed publicly. The Clerk of the Court, upon receiving such Notice, shall unseal the case and file documents on the public docket. Plaintiffs shall be permitted upon filing of such Notice to disclose any such material as deemed necessary to commence their efforts to provide Defendants notice of any further hearings and service of pleadings associated with Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Application for an Emergency Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction.
