DECLARATION OF ANNA Z. SABER IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS' REQUEST FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT

I, Anna Z. Saber, declare as follows:

1. I am an attorney admitted to practice in the State of California. I am a Counsel at the law firm of Crowell & Moring LLP, counsel of record for the plaintiffs in this matter, Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") and LF Projects, LLC (collectively, "Plaintiffs"). I make this declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Request for Entry of Default against Abanoub Nady and John Does 1-4 (the "Fake ONNX Defendants"), who conduct and facilitate phishing attacks through their manufacture, sale, and deployment of phishing kits that enable other cybercriminals to launch phishing attacks against Microsoft and its customers. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called to testify as a witness, could and would testify to the following under oath.

A. **Fake ONNX Defendants Have Not Responded To This Action Or Otherwise Objected To The Relief Requested In This Action**

2. As described more fully below, Nady and John Doe Defendants 1-4 (“Fake ONNX Defendants”) have been properly served the Complaint, summons, and all orders, pleadings and evidence in this action pursuant to the means authorized by the Court in the Temporary Restraining Order (Dkt. No. 16) and Preliminary Injunction Order (Dkt. No. 31), and the Fake ONNX Defendants have failed to plead or otherwise defend the action.

3. As of June 4, 2026, I have not been contacted by any of the Fake ONNX Defendants regarding this case or at all. I have also conferred with members of the Microsoft’s Digital Crime Unit (the division of Microsoft responsible for protecting Microsoft and its customers against cybercrime threats, and is the unit responsible for investigating cybersecurity threats and identifying and attributing attacks) and Jason Lyon (the DCU investigator who was responsible to investigating Fake ONNX and served as a technical declarant in connection with the TRO Application and Preliminary Injunctions). DCU confirms that neither Microsoft, nor any party associated with it, have been contacted by any of the Fake ONNX Defendants regarding this case or at all. Fake ONNX Defendants have not objected to the relief obtained in the Temporary Restraining Order the Preliminary Injunction Order, or any Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Order, or any other order of the Court. Fake ONNX Defendants have not objected to or disputed any pleading, declaration, fact, evidence or submission in this case.

4. The 21-day time for Fake ONNX Defendants to respond to the complaint under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12 has expired, as Fake ONNX Defendants were served with the Complaint and other pleadings on December 1, 2024 via email and publication and were provided notice of case activities via email and publication. Fake ONNX Defendants’ time to respond was December 23, 2024.

5. Upon information and belief, the Fake ONNX Defendants against whom an entry

of default is sought are not infants, minors, nor incompetent persons. I base this conclusion on the fact that Fake ONNX Defendants have engaged in sophisticated acts of phishing, computer intrusion, and theft of sensitive information from computer networks and have operated a sophisticated phishing-as-a-service cybercrime infrastructure. I have also seen no indication that Fake ONNX Defendants are absent or have failed to file responsive pleadings due to present military service.

B. The Fake ONNX Defendants Have Been Properly Served

6. I submit that it is most reasonable to conclude that Fake ONNX Defendants are aware of this proceeding given the significant impact of the TRO and, preliminary injunction and supplemental preliminary injunction on their operations, in combination with the steps Plaintiffs took to serve process by email and through publication, discussed below.

7. As set forth and reflected in Plaintiffs' request for TRO and request for preliminary injunction and supplemental preliminary injunctions, following execution of these orders, Microsoft seized the subject domain names that Fake ONNX Defendants owned, operated, and controlled to conduct their spear phishing operation, target victims, gain unauthorized access to their accounts and information, and exfiltrate sensitive information. As attested, this mechanism was designed to interrupt Fake ONNX Defendants' attacks by removing infrastructure used to deceive victims of phishing emails and severing communications between the infected operating systems and devices of victims and the Fake ONNX Defendants. *See* Declaration of Jason Lyons ISO Microsoft's Applications For An Emergency *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. No. 4-1), ¶¶ 65-69. Accordingly, I believe that this effectively interrupted Fake ONNX Defendants' attacks by severing communications between their technical control center and the victims of their phishing activities. Given this disruption and impact on the Fake ONNX Defendants'

infrastructure, I conclude that Fake ONNX Defendants are very likely to be aware of the impact of the relief granted through the course of this action and to be aware of the fact that the instant proceeding is the cause of that impact.

8. Additionally in connection with effectuating the TRO and preliminary injunction and seeking transfer of the domains, the registries that administer the domains informed me that they had notified the impacted registrars of the transfer and advised the registrars that any future questions would be directed to counsel for Plaintiffs. That is, if the prior registrant (the prior owner) of the domain had questions about why their domain was taken down, their questions would ultimately be directed to Plaintiffs' counsel. To date, Plaintiffs' counsel has not received any correspondence from anyone claiming that their domain was improperly taken down. Nor have the registries or registrars alerted us to any user complaints or questions.

1. Service By Email

9. Plaintiffs have served process through email, as authorized by the TRO, and Preliminary Injunction Order. The Court has authorized service by email, as follows: "the Complaint may be served by any means authorized by law, including (1) transmission by email . . . to the contact information provided by Fake ONNX Defendants to Defendants' domain registrars and/or hosting companies and as agreed to by Fake ONNX Defendants in the domain registration and/or hosting agreements." Dkt. 16 at p. 11.

10. Through Plaintiffs' pre-filing investigation and through the Doe discovery process in this case, Plaintiffs' in-house investigators and attorneys at Crowell & Moring LLP gathered contact information, particularly email addresses, associated with the Fake ONNX Defendants' domain names. Fake ONNX Defendants had provided these email addresses to domain registrar companies when completing the registration process for the domain names used in Fake ONNX Defendants' command and control infrastructure. I used this contact information to serve the

Fake ONNX Defendants by email.

11. In this case, the email addresses provided by Fake ONNX Defendants to the domain registrars are the most accurate and viable contact information and means of notice and service. *See* Declaration of Jeffrey L. Poston ISO Microsoft's Applications for an Emergency *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. 4-2), ¶¶ 10, 19-25. While Fake ONNX Defendants may provide false or stolen names and addresses to registrars, in order to receive access to their domains and manage their account, Fake ONNX Defendants will likely provide an operational, active email address to the domain registrars. Fake ONNX Defendants will have expected notice regarding their use of the domain names by the email addresses that they provided to their domain registrars. *Id.* For example, domain registrar policies require Fake ONNX Defendants to provide accurate email contact information to domain registrars to use such information to provide notice of complaints and to send other account-related communications about the domain names, including communications which result in suspension or cancellation of the domain names. *Id.*

12. Given that Fake ONNX Defendants relied upon these domain names to deceive users, to obtain unauthorized access to victim accounts and victim data, and to operate their spear phishing operation it would be crucial for Fake ONNX Defendants to monitor account status of these domains. The email addresses associated with the domain names are the means by which they did so.

13. On December 1, 2024, I served copies of the Complaint, TRO, Preliminary Injunction Order, and all other pleadings, declarations, evidence, orders and other submissions in this action, by attaching those documents to the emails sent to the email addresses associated with the domain names used by the Fake ONNX Defendants (the email addresses listed as

“registrant emails” on Appendix A to the Complaint, Dkt. No. 1-1). In each such email I included a link to the website <https://noticeofpleadings.com/FAKEONNX/>, at which the pleadings, declarations, evidence and orders filed in this action could also be accessed.

14. The service emails contained the following language:

Plaintiffs Microsoft Corporation (“Microsoft”) and LF Projects, LLC have sued Defendants Abanoub Nady and John Does 1-4 associated with the Fake ONNX cybercriminal operation and domains listed in the documents set forth herein. You are receiving this email because you are the registrant of a domain that Fake ONNX Defendants use as part of their cybercriminal operation. Plaintiffs allege that the Fake ONNX Defendants have violated Federal and state law by hosting a cybercriminal operation through these domains and selling, distributing, purchasing, and implementing the “ONNX”-branded phishing kits that support a Phishing-as-a-Service enterprise. The phishing kits made and sold by the Fake ONNX Defendants facilitate sophisticated spear phishing and are designed to steal sensitive information that is then used to perpetrate additional cybercrimes including business email compromise, financial fraud, and ransomware attacks. Fake ONNX Defendants have also committed intellectual property violations irreparably harming Plaintiffs and Plaintiffs’ customers and member organizations. Plaintiffs seek a preliminary injunction directing the registrars associated with these domains to take all steps necessary to disable access to and operation of these domains and that all content and material associated with these domains are to be isolated and preserved pending resolution of the dispute. Plaintiffs seek a permanent injunction, other equitable relief and damages. Full copies of the pleading documents are available at www.noticeofpleadings.com/fakeonnx.

NOTICE TO DEFENDANTS: READ THESE PAPERS CAREFULLY! You must “appear” in this case or the other side will win automatically. To “appear” you must file with the court a legal document called a “motion” or “answer.” The “motion” or “answer” must be given to the court clerk or administrator within 21 days of the date of first publication specified herein. It must be in proper form and have proof of service on the Plaintiffs’ attorneys, Jeffrey L. Poston at Crowell & Moring LLP, 1001 Pennsylvania Avenue NW, Washington D.C. 20004, jposton@crowell.com. If you have questions, you should consult with your own attorney immediately.

NOTICE TO DEFENDANTS: The Court has ORDERED that the Show Cause Hearing re Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction will be SCHEDULED for December 4, 2024 at 1:00 pm in Courtroom 1000 at the Alexandria Courthouse in the Eastern District of Virginia before Judge Rossie D. Alston, Jr.

15. In connection with sending the service email to the registrant emails as identified in Appendix A, I used Readnotify.com to track the email correspondence. By appending

“readnotify.com” to the end of each of the registrant’s emails, I am able to track the correspondence, including when the email is received and when it is opened (to the extent the recipient opens the email). I have reviewed the ReadNotify.com records, and have confirmed that successful delivery (i.e., no bounce back) of the emails and have confirmed that in many instances the service email was opened by the recipient.

16. Despite this robust notice and service, the Fake ONNX Defendants have not contacted me, anyone at my firm, Microsoft, LF Projects, nor any other party associated with Microsoft or LF Projects. Despite notice and service, Fake ONNX Defendants have not objected to the relief obtained in the Temporary Restraining Order, the Preliminary Injunction Order, or any other order in the case. Nor have Fake ONNX Defendants objected to or disputed any pleading, declaration, fact, evidence or submission in this case.

2. Service By Internet Publication

17. Plaintiffs have served process by Internet publication, as authorized by the TRO and Preliminary Injunction Order. The Court has authorized service by Internet publication, as follows: “the Complaint may be served by any means authorized by law, including . . . publishing notice on a publicly available Internet website.” Dkt. 16 at p. 11.

18. On November 21, 2024, the “Notice of Pleadings” website, which is hosted by Crowell & Moring, went live. This website contains copies of the pleadings filed in this case to date, including the Court Orders, the Complaint, Summons, briefing, and all other pleadings. I visited the Notice of Pleadings website and confirmed that all the posted documents were in fact accessible to the public. A true and accurate copy of the homepage for <https://noticeofpleadings.com/FAKEONNX/> is attached to my declaration as **Exhibit 1**.

19. The Notice of Pleadings website contains the case caption as well as the following language:

Plaintiffs Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") and LF Projects have sued Defendants Abanoub Nady and John Does 1-4 associated with the Fake ONNX cybercriminal operation and domains listed in the documents set forth herein. Plaintiffs allege that the Fake ONNX Defendants have violated Federal and state law by hosting a cybercriminal operation through these domains and selling, distributing, purchasing, and implementing the "ONNX"-branded phishing kits that support a Phishing-as-a-Service enterprise. The phishing kits mad and sold by the Fake ONNX Defendants facilitate sophisticated spear phishing and are designed to steal sensitive information that is then used to perpetrate additional cybercrimes including business email compromise, financial fraud, and ransomware attacks. Fake ONNX Defendants have also committed intellectual property violations irreparably harming Plaintiffs and Plaintiffs' customers and member organizations. Plaintiffs seek a preliminary injunction directing the registrars associated with these domains to take all steps necessary to disable access to and operation of these domains and that all content and material associated with these domains are to be isolated and preserved pending resolution of the dispute. Plaintiffs seek a permanent injunction, other equitable relief and damages. Full copies of the pleading documents are available at www.noticeofpleadings.com/fakeonnx.

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20. A link to the foregoing website was included in each service of process email sent to Fake ONNX Defendants at the email addresses determined to be associated with the Fake ONNX Defendants' domain names used in the Fake ONNX Defendants' operations.

21. Following execution of the TRO and the unsealing of the records in this action, Plaintiffs also engaged in widespread press relations and media activity announcing this action. See Steven Masada, *Targeting the Cybercrime Supply Chain*, Microsoft Blog, available at <https://blogs.microsoft.com/on-the-issues/2024/11/21/targeting-the-cybercrime-supply-chain/> (Nov. 21, 2024). If Fake ONNX Defendants were made aware of the action via Plaintiffs' media activity they would have been able to access the Notice of Pleadings website and access the pleadings.

3. Attempted Notice And Service By Mail Or Personal Delivery

22. I have investigated each physical mailing address listed in the information associated with the domain names used by the Fake ONNX Defendants and in the records regarding those domain names obtained during discovery. These addresses reflected: (1) incomplete addresses, such as only the names of cities without further detail, (2) addresses that are simply artificial and do not exist at all, (3) street names that exist but not properly correlated to other address information and associated with individuals or companies that do not exist, and (4) city names that are not properly correlated to the listed country or which combine elements of different cities in different countries. This suggests that the addresses are fabricated by the Fake

ONNX Defendants, and therefore the email addresses associated with the domain names that were used to operate the phishing-as-a-service operation are the most viable way to communicate with the Fake ONNX Defendants in this action. Because Fake ONNX Defendants provided these email addresses when registering the domain names used as the technical infrastructure of their cybercrime operations making it likely that Fake ONNX Defendants at least monitor messages sent to those addresses.

C. Plaintiffs Have Made Substantial, But Unsuccessful, Efforts To Discover And Investigate The Fake ONNX Defendants' Particular Identities.


23. On behalf of Plaintiffs, I endeavored to identify additional contact information through which Fake ONNX Defendants could be served, as well as more specific identities. Pursuant to the Court's order authorizing Doe Discovery (Dkt. No. 37), I served seventeen subpoenas to the U.S.-based domain registrars seeking account information, identifying information, payment information, device information, and communications with the account holders in an effort to obtain additional information regarding Fake ONNX Defendants' identities.

24. Based on my review of the responses and documents provided by these registrars, as well as Microsoft's technical analysis of the information provided, Microsoft has not been able to identify Fake ONNX Defendants with any greater particularity through the discovery responses.

25. Given (a) Fake ONNX Defendants' use of aliases and false information, (b) their use of anonymous proxy computers or anonymization networks to create and maintain the infrastructure at issue in the case (c) the absence of or limitations on the ability to carry out U.S.-style civil discovery outside of the U.S., (d) the ease with which anonymous activities can be

carried out through the Internet and (e) the sophistication of the Fake ONNX Defendants in using tools to conceal more specific indicia of their identities or further contact information, I have been unable to specifically and definitively determine the “real” names and physical addresses of Fake ONNX Defendants, at which they might be served by personal service.
