ORDER

On April 15, 2022, the undersigned Magistrate Judge presided over a hearing on Plaintiffs’ Motion for Default Judgment [Dkt. No. 36]. At that hearing, this Court informed Plaintiffs’ counsel that it would take the matter under advisement and issue a report and recommendation to the District Judge. After further review of the documentation in support of Plaintiffs’ Motion for Default Judgment, this Court has concerns about the amount of damages. Specifically, this Court has concerns about the lack of detail and specificity on the “damages of more than \$5,000” alleged in the Complaint. Therefore, the Court will allow counsel for the Plaintiffs to file supplemental briefing explaining what the damages are, and how the damages were calculated. If no supplemental briefing is filed by 5 p.m. on December 16, 2022, this Court will move forward and issue its report and recommendation.
