## UNSEALING ORDER

previously filed UNDER SEAL – with the exception of the Declaration of Natalia Krapiva

Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause Re Preliminary Injunction ("Krapiva Declaration"), which shall remain under seal until further order of the court. Other than the Krapiva Declaration [ECF 4 – attachment 5], all other documents shall be accessible on the public docket, and publicized and/or otherwise disseminated by Plaintiffs in connection with their efforts to provide Defendants with notice of the preliminary injunction hearing and service of the Complaint. A previously filed redacted copy of the Krapiva Declaration will be accessible on the public docket upon the unsealing of this case [ECF 14-3].
