**NOTICE OF EXECUTION OF SUPPLEMENTAL INJUNCTION ORDER  
AND NOTICE RE UNSEALING OF DOCUMENTS**

On November 14, 2016, Plaintiff Microsoft Corp. (“Plaintiff”) moved *ex parte* for a supplemental preliminary injunction order pursuant to Civil Procedure 53, 65(a), the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act (18 U.S.C. § 1030), the Electronic Communications Privacy Act (18 U.S.C. § 2701), the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. §§ 1114 & 1125), the Anti-Cybersquatting Consumer Protection Act (15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)), the common law, and the All Writs Act, (28 U.S.C. § 1651). On December 2, 2016, the matter was heard and this Court granted Plaintiff’s request for a supplemental injunction order (“Supplemental Order”) on December 6, 2016. In connection with the Supplemental Order, this Court granted Plaintiff’s Motion for a Protective Order Temporarily Sealing Documents, directing that, pending the execution of the Supplemental Order, related documents (Dkt. Nos. 40-44) be filed UNDER SEAL pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(c)(1) such that they are not accessible on the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (“PACER”) website or otherwise appear on the public docket.

This Court further ordered that the above-referenced documents be unsealed immediately upon execution of the *ex parte* relief sought in the Supplemental Order and, to that end, ordered that Plaintiff file with the Clerk of the Court a Notice that the *ex parte* relief sought in the Supplemental Order had been executed such that the related documents may appear on the public docket and Plaintiff be permitted to disclose the documents in its effort to provide Defendants with notice of the Supplemental Order.

Accordingly, Plaintiff hereby files this Notice Of Execution Of Supplemental Injunction Order And Notice Re Unsealing Of Documents and certifies that, execution having been made pursuant to this Court's Supplemental Order dated December 6, 2016, the above-referenced documents may be immediately unsealed such that materials previously filed UNDER SEAL be accessible on the PACER website, appear on the public docket, and publicized and/or otherwise disseminated by Plaintiff in connection with its efforts to provide Defendants with notice of the Supplemental Order.
